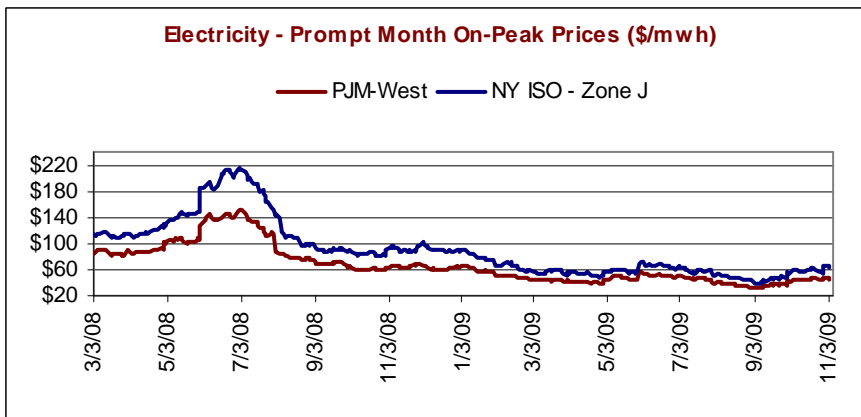
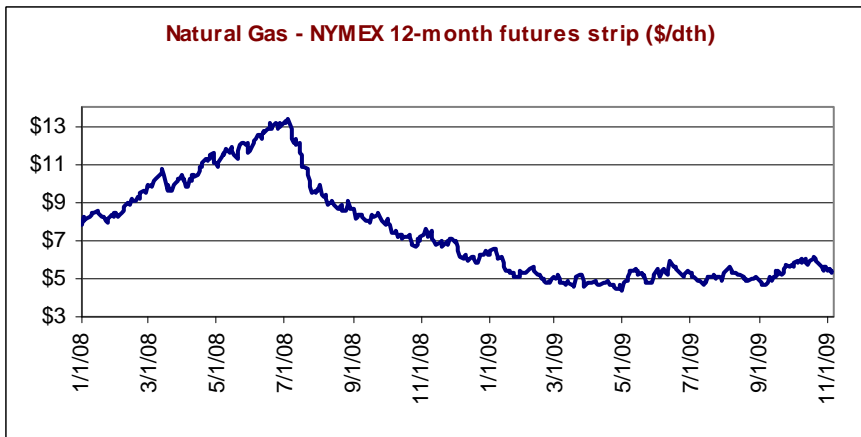


### MARKET OUTLOOK
